Instructor Class Prerequisites

All prospective participants in an Instructor Course must:

- Have current HCP Provider status in the discipline they wish to teach (bring your card as we need a copy).
- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Have completed an Instructor Candidate Application (Can be done in class)
- Present a copy of your completed AHA Core Instructor Course or complete the Core Instructor Course (contact Judy Gau at 440-735-3513) or order through the AHA. You must present your completion certificate on the day of your class.
- All Instructor Course candidates must have the most current edition of the required AHA HCP Provider textbooks and Instructor's manuals. Bring them both to class with you. Your HCP Instructor Manual is included in the cost of the class. Other AHA materials can be purchased from Judy or the AHA.

After the class:

- Within 6 months of successfully completing the Instructor Course, the candidate must successfully demonstrate his or her ability to teach at a HCP Class. You will be monitored by a current UHEMS Institute Regional Faculty/TCF member during your course, and the required monitoring forms returned to the TC.
